The above solicitation was issued by the Whatcom Transportation Authority (WTA) on January 19, 2022. At the original date of submission, of 25 known plan holders, only two (2) responses were received. Knowing that there were more firms in the marketplace, WTA staff reopened the solicitation on February 14 and extended the submission deadline to March 4.

Vendors were solicited through an advertisement in The Bellingham Herald and TransitTalent.com, a posting on Washington's Electronic Business Solution (WEBS), Washington's Office of Women and Minority Business Enterprise (owmbe.org), and Washington Procurement Technical Assistance Center, an announcement on WTA's website, and an email notice to proposers from a small purchase request in early 2021.
