

MODIFICATION OF AGREEMENT # 2

This modification is made between WHATCOM COMMUNITY COLLEGE, (WCC) and WHATCOM TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY (WTA). On October 27, 2016, WCC and WTA entered into an agreement providing student passes to students based on quarterly full-time equivalent (FTE) number. Passes would be loaded to the student card and the fee to WCC charged quarterly. This contract expires August 31, 2022.

WHEREAS both WTA and WCC have declared a state of emergency in response to the COVID19 outbreak; and

WHEREAS WTA has temporarily ceased collecting fares with a resumption date to be determined; and

WHEREAS the WCC campus is temporarily closed and all classes are being taught online;

THEREFORE, WCC and WTA agree to the following:

1. **PAYMENT:** Payment for the Spring Quarter 2020 student passes is suspended. Student ID cards will not be required to board WTA buses while fares are suspended.


The agencies will evaluate Summer Quarter 2020 payment no later than May 1, 2020, if applicable.

Should WTA resume fare collection during Spring Quarter 2020, WTA will notify WCC immediately. WTA will prorate the remaining fee due for the balance of the quarter based on enrolled FTE's at the time fares are reinstated. WCC will have 30 days to pay the prorated fee. Students will need to present their ID card to board WTA buses once fares are reinstated.

2. **FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT CALCULATION:** An FTE student is one that takes 12 credits or more. WCC will deduct basic education, , non-credit-seeking, and Running Start students from its FTE calculation.
3. **TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EXISTING AGREEMENT REMAIN THE SAME:** WCC and WTA agree the terms and conditions of the original Agreement remain in effect except for the items noted.

4. **COUNTERPARTS:** Original signatures transmitted and received via electronic transmission of a scanned document (e.g. PDF or similar format) are true and valid signatures for all purposes of this Agreement and shall bind the parties to the same extent as that of an original signature. Signatures submitted electronically must be fully legible to be valid
