EXTENSION OF AGREEMENT # 2

This extension is made between PROSCAPES, INC., (CONTRACTOR) and the WHATCOM TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY (WTA). On January 8, 2018, CONTRACTOR and WTA entered into an agreement that provides landscape maintenance services including snow removal. This contract is renewable for 5 years after the initial term, in one (1) year increments. CONTRACTOR and WTA both wish to renew the Agreement for one (1) year.

CONTRACTOR and WTA agree to the following:

- 1. **RENEWAL OF EXISTING AGREEMENT**: The Agreement shall be renewed for one year, effective April 30, 2019 through April 29, 2020.
- PREVAILING WAGE: Pursuant to RCW 39.12.040, CONTRACTOR will file a new intent to pay prevailing wage with Washington State Labor & Industries for this new contract term.
- 3. **TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EXISTING AGREEMENT REMAIN THE SAME:** CONTRACTOR and WTA agree the terms and conditions of the original Agreement remain in effect except for the items noted.
- 4. **COUNTER PARTS:** Original signatures transmitted and received via electronic transmission of a scanned document (e.g. PDF or similar format) are true and valid signatures for all purposes of this Agreement and shall bind the parties to the same extent as that of an original signature. Signatures submitted electronically must be fully legible to be valid.
